The MyCreds™ virtual wallet will allow Trent students and graduates to access official documents and credentials securely via the online portal.

Effective today, Trent University joins MyCreds[™], the National Network and credential wallet developed and owned by the Association of Registrars of the Universities and Colleges of Canada (ARUCC).

Trent will use MyCreds™ as the secure and official means to issue a suite of academic documents including Parchments, Transcripts, Confirmation of Graduation letters and Confirmation of Enrolment letters. Trent will also become a registered receiving organization on the network, allowing learners worldwide to send their documents to the institution directly via the MyCreds™ portal.
